The FSGA *Most Improved Player* award is based upon the player's Official Handicap as issued by the Golf Handicap and Information Network [**GHIN**], a USGA service. The Improvement Factor compares the player's handicap at the end of the season to a beginning handicap earlier in the year. The player with the highest improvement factor is the most improved player.
